Fashion Fantasy Class



Class F3 “Wearable Art” allows entrants to be as creative as they wish.

- Design ideas are only limited to your imagination, but you must explain your idea on the entry form.
- Entrants in this class may not necessarily sew their garments, but will receive extra points if they do. Purchased outfits can be used and embellished.
- Any materials/objects can be used to create the required design.
- You do not have to be a sewer to enter this class.
- **Minimum entry age – 15 years. Models must be 15 years of age or over. Please ensure that the age of the model is appropriate to the type of garment i.e. if the garment is deemed to be an adults only type outfit then the model must be an adult.**

Please Note:-

- This competition is open to amateurs i.e. to all persons who **DO NOT DERIVE ANY INCOME** from dressmaking, adult fashion designing, and/or conduct sewing classes.
- The classes are open to all individuals 15 years and over as well as all students of a high school, college or tertiary facility.
- All entry forms (both sides completed) must include coloured photographs of both the front and back of the completed outfit .
- 1st and 2nd placed entrant at the Quilt Show will be eligible to attend the final at the State Competition.
- All entries will be required to be shown at the Kenilworth Show & Rodeo on September 18, 2010.
- Entrants who have previously been placed 1st at a State Final are still eligible to enter.
- Any outfit that has won 1st prize at a previous year’s Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies Fashion Fantasy competition cannot be entered in this competition again.
- \$100 1st Prize \$50 2nd Prize. 1st & 2nd prize winners will be eligible to attend the final at the State Competition in August, 2010.
- Fee \$5 per entry

General Terms and Conditions

1. The entrant is the person who made the garment. Each outfit is to be the bona fide work of the entrant. If the model is not the entrant, the name and contact details of the model are to be included on page 2 of the Entry Form, together with details of the parent/guardian if under 16.
2. **IF ENTRANT OR MODEL IS UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS THE ENTRY FORM IS TO BE COMPLETED BY THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN AND THE MODEL'S PARENTS OR GUARDIAN IS TO SIGN THE PERMISSION PART OF THE ENTRY FORM.**
3. Each entry is to be a complete outfit – suit, dress, skirt/pants & top. No part outfits will be accepted. Purchased items may be used in Fashion Fantasy Classes.
4. Each entry is to be a single garment – not a pair of garments.
5. **No professional models allowed.** The same person is to model at the judging and the parade and he/she is to be able to model without assistance.
6. If the garment has been entered at a previous State Final, that garment cannot be entered in any other classes or future competitions.
7. Commercial patterns may be used.
8. The outfit is to be **new**, but pre-washing of fabric is allowed. Outfit is **not** to be worn prior to the State Final except at local judging.
9. A description of each outfit is to be attached to the B side of the Entry Form. No brand names or identification tags to be attached to the outfit. The description of the outfit is used to create the script the announcer will use to promote your entry. Please add any comments that you would like people to know. Fashion Fantasy entrants must attach coloured photographs of the front and back of the entry to allow the script to be produced.
10. An entrant may represent only **one Show Society per class** at the State Final. An entrant may enter a class and/or the competition **under one name only**
11. The 1st and 2nd placed outfit of the Quilt Show will be eligible to compete at the State final to be held in Brisbane in August. All finalists will be advised of dates, times etc. prior to the State Competition.
12. An outfit may be entered into 1 class only.
13. If an entrant has more than 1 garment entered (regardless of class), **the entrant may model 1 outfit only**. A model is to be obtained for any other garments they have entered.
14. **THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL AND NO CORRESPONDENCE WILL BE ENTERED INTO.**
15. The ages of the competitions will be calculated from 1st August in the year of the competition.
